

## It all began in a bog

IN 1825, AT THE AGE OF FORTY-NINE, HENRIETTE DANNESKIOLD-SAMSØE WAS WIDOWED AND LEFT WITH THE HOLMEGAARD MANOR, INCLUDING 3500 ACRES OF BOG LAND. PEAT AND AN ENTERPRISING WOMAN SOON HAD THE FIRST FURNACE GLOWING AND THE REST IS HISTORY.

For the first couple of years only green bottles left the Holmegaard Glassworks, but our countess aimed higher. Goblets in clear glass were the fashion, and in Bohemia they knew how to blow them. Soon new furnaces were blazing and Holmegaard could set the table with Madeira glasses, pinch bottles, hyacinth glasses, hipflasks, and potpourri jars.

Her son, Christian Conrad Sophus, moved the bottle production to the newly built Kastrup Glassworks, and Holmegaard could concentrate on the fine art of glassmaking. Increasingly sophisticated techniques attracted inventive artists, and a tradition of developing and designing would soon establish Denmark's oldest glassworks as a benchmark in glassware.

Today Holmegaard designs and makes glasses blown by mouth and machine using the latest and most advanced methods. Each piece of glass blown by mouth is unique and handmade by glassmakers, blowing the exactly right amount of air through his narrow pipe. Variations and small bubbles in the glass are inevitable and form part of the charm that characterizes a glass made by mouth and hand.

Glasses blown by mouth at Holmegaard are recognized by the Swan logo. With its crown and three waves, it is the crest of Danneskiold-Samsøe. Not to put on airs, but as a testament to the heritage and tradition of fine glassmaking.



"GLASS IS LIFE." Holmegaard has a long and strong tradition of working with some of today's most prominent designers and challenging the unique material that glass is. One of the most prolific was Per Lütken who created over 3,000 designs for Holmegaard: "Glass stimulates our senses," he said. "It is beautiful to look at, great to hold, functional and practical. Most amazing of all, it is both fragile and flexible."

The Provence bowl, designed by Per Lütken in 1955, is a signature product for Holmegaard. It is living proof of how ideas arise when the designer leaves the studio and moves around in the workshop. 

# The Egg, the Swan and the glasses

ARNE JACOBSEN WAS A MAN OF THE FUTURE. PEOPLE WOULD HAVE TO GET USED TO HIS IDEAS. AT THE SAS ROYAL HOTEL, HE FILLED HIS RIGHT ANGLES WITH ROUNDED SHAPES AND LAID THE WORLD AT HIS FEET.

Arne Jacobsen's output was enormous. It grew out of a philosophy of creating total concepts, where everything was thought over again and designed from scratch. A common thread ran through the building, the furniture and the interior.

For the SAS Royal, he created not only the world-famous armchairs, but also lamps, textiles, door handles and a series of drinking glasses that Holmegaard now re-launches in its entirety.

Combining design and architecture, the SAS Royal Hotel became the world's first designer hotel and unparalleled in its time. The concept was brilliant. The tight, orthogonal outline was filled with round, organic furniture and objects. Architecture and handicrafts had their own language, but emphasized each other's qualities.


Nearly sixty years later, the seven glasses espress the architect's sense of bringing pleasure to the table. Wine, aperitifs, cocktails, beer, schnapps, and liqueurs — all made in the 'fine glass' quality, as a tribute to everything good in life.



ARNE JACOBSEN (1902-1971) was one of the most influential Danish architects and designers of the 20th century. He was educated at the School of Architecture in Copenhagen, where he later became professor of architecture. Internationally, he is recognized as one of the leading pioneers of functionalism. He was renowned for his complete solutions that included furniture, textiles, lamps, glassware, cutlery, door handles, and more.

In all his projects, Arne Jacobsen designed all objects himself. It never occurred to him to use other's products. Many of his lamps and furniture were developed exclusively for his buildings, which were decorated entirely in keeping with his view of the world.

The Royal series are the only glasses known to stem from Jacobsen's hand. They were originally produced at the Kastrup Glassworks, which in 1965 merged with Holmegaard. All glasses in the series bear the architect's signature sandblasted on the foot. As a small tribute to a man with big ideas.



# Good beer in better company

THESE TIMES CALL FOR WELL-BREWED BEER. MICRO BOILERS FERMENT AND BASEMENTS SIZZLE, AND DISCERNING PALATES ARE GETTING WELL ACCUSTOMED TO IT. IF IT IS UP TO HOLMEGAARD TO DECIDE, THE HOST WILL SERVE A SELECTION OF GLASSES TO THE GUEST'S TASTE.

With the Humle series, Holmegaard has created a well-tuned line-up offering contemporary beer culture its own glass series; for lager or wheat beer, ale and stout. Glassmaker Torben Jørgensen has designed Humle. Here is a man who likes to follow his tastes.

"The thickness is important. It keeps the beer at the right temperature, which is essential for aroma, taste and experience. The same applies to the foot, which isolates the beer from the substrate."

Pilsner and wheat beer have low bitterness and weak acidity, which call for high cups to ensure that the beer hits the back of the mouth and the perception is fresh. Tilt the bottle 45 degrees and pour in a smooth and steady rhythm.

With its spacious surface, the beer glass of the Cabernet series presents the brew's best properties. It is both suitable for ice-cold lager or heavier beers that require room to flex their muscles.



A WELL-BLOWN BEER GLASS elevates the experience and lets the content step into character. Holmegaaard have no less than 10 different designs to offer, with and without feet. Now, should you start collecting the whole series or mix and let your guests choose to their liking?

# A florist's sense of magic

NOT ONLY HAS HE GREEN FINGERS. CLAUS DALBY USED TO BE A MAGICIAN.
AND HE HAS A WEAKNESS FOR CLASSIC ENGLISH GARDENING.

"Many years ago I bought this antique flower trophy in England, which has been my favourite ever since if a bouquet should present itself from its best side. When Holmegaard called, I never doubted which way we should go."

The transparent lightness, supported by the foot, puts the flowers on a pedestal. The narrow waist gathers the stems, while the spacious bowl provides room for the bouquet to unfold. Old English is designed to bring out the best in the flowers, making them stand out with grace and beauty.

The Old English comes in two sizes and as a floor vase. The soft lines and curves are repeated in a series of flower bowls for bulbous plants or floating flower heads. This year, we continue the line with Solitaire vases in three heights for a single flower or more, a small flower bowl and a tea light bowl.

CLAUS DALBY (1963) is an author, publisher, garden blogger, flower enthusiast, and the host of several television programs. Since 2014, he can add designer to his business card, as he began his collaboration with Holmegaard developing the Old English series of vases and flower bowls.

# **Everything flows**

Flower heads floating in water are one of the hallmarks of the romantic English garden tradition. The Old English flower bowl borrows its design from the vases in the same series, and the latest addition is a small bowl with a diameter of just 13 cm. Use the bowls for decorations with flower heads or succulents. Or for Easter eggs of advent wreaths, strawberries, Christmas cookies or candy or...



# Time for twilight

The hand blown tealight holder is the latest addition to the Old English series by flower specialist Claus Dalby and Holmegaard. With its spacious bowl, it bears clear resemblance to the vases and bowls of the same series, while adding lustre upstairs and downstairs.

# What colour is your mood?


Dancing flames reflected through coloured glass is the inspiration behind the LUMI candle holders, which are Maria Berntsen's interpretation of the classic candlestick. Create your own expression depending on the season and your mood with 1-armed holders in two heights or the 4-armed holder. All have replaceable candle-cuffs in different shapes and shades of glass. Smoke is default, but other colours can be purchased and the party begun. LUMI candle holder of metal with matt black powder coating and candle-cuffs in painted glass.



### Let your heart speak

"Whenever I face a new task, I'm looking for a sentiment, a spirit," says Maria Berntsen. "It's like stepping into a sacred room where the heart is allowed to speak. I see the product before me, how it will look in use and in space. I never care about form and function before I've grasped that feeling." Maria Berntsen is an industrial designer and has had her own design studio since 1992. She made the series Design with Lights and recently LUMI for Holmegaard.

### Not like the others

The hurricane lantern of the Design with Light series uses ordinary lamp oil and a fibre wick, which does not soot like candles. Borosilicate glass makes it heat- and impact-resistant, while the leather strap makes it easy to carry and hang on the terrace, on the boat, in a tree and so on. With time, the leather will wear as a testimony to quiet moments of quality.

### When the glass decides

With Cocoon, it was Peter Svarrer's ambition to create a mouth blown vase that breaks the light in the special way that only glass can. It took him three years before the mould fell into place. In return, he stood with a classic that captures the eye and elevates your mood, even without flowers in it. Peter Svarrer trained at the Copenhagen School of Art and has had his own glass studio since 1982. For Holmegaard, his organic idiom has resulted in i.a. the series Cabernet, Future and Cocoon.



# A good glass makes the wine soar

Choosing the right glass for the wine is a religion to some. Others are satisfied as long as the content has room to show its potential. To Holmegaard, it's a matter of scope and variety and we recommend that you use your taste buds.



#### Perfection

The small break in the bowl outlines Perfection's character and functionality: A pouring line to ensure that the glass is filled with the correct quantity helps the wine develop its flavour and fragrance.

Technically, Perfection is a fully moulded glass. That is, in one piece with a drawn stem, giving the glass extraordinarily high strength.

Anyone can pull the cork from a bottle. Making its content open up, taming the bouquet and showing the wine's true format, that's Perfection.

#### Cabernet

A good wine glass heightens the experience and helps the wine produce its properties in the best light. Cabernet is about eyes, nose and palate, but it's a pleasure for your fingertips, too. Peter Svarrer rises to the occasion with a keen eye for the aesthetic experience.

Cabernet is a perfect shape, moulded in one piece with a drawn stem. The tulip shape gives space to fling the wine without letting the bouquet leave the glass.

With stylish lightness, Cabernet combines a classic shape with feminine elegance, making the glassware easy to be around, be it the grand setup or on a humble weekday.

#### Bouquet

Bouquet is a term borrowed from the world of wine addressing the fragrance of a wine that has aged in the bottle. For connoisseurs, it is part of the enjoyment to employ your nose before the glass is fed to your lips.

With Bouquet, Peter Svarrer has created a contemporary form that plays with your senses as a tribute to the ceremony around wine tasting.

A wide base ensures ample space for the wine to aerate, while the sloping walls close in on the bouquet, leaving room for your nose. The shape is created in one piece with a pulled stem for high robustness.

TOM NYBROE is a wine aficionado, a wine importer and the designer of the award-winning Perfection series for Holmegaard.



PETER SVARRER trained at the Copenhagen School of Art and has had his own glass studio since 1982. His design philosophy is devoted to the organic and functional, but always on the conditions of the glass itself.



PETER SVARRER is also known as The Light Master, because his designs are based on the ability to catch and reflect the light in a way that only glass can.

### It's never too early

If you have a heart for Christmas, December is made of gold and ribbons and anything that glitters. This year's evocative decorations for trees and windows by Ann-Sofi Romme are not just collectibles. They are gifts that will bring back sweet memories year after year. Ann-Sofi Romme (1957) studied ceramics at the Kolding School of Design in 1981, but this hasn't kept her from working with glass, porcelain, gold, silver and gems. The collaboration with Holmegaard began in 2005.


